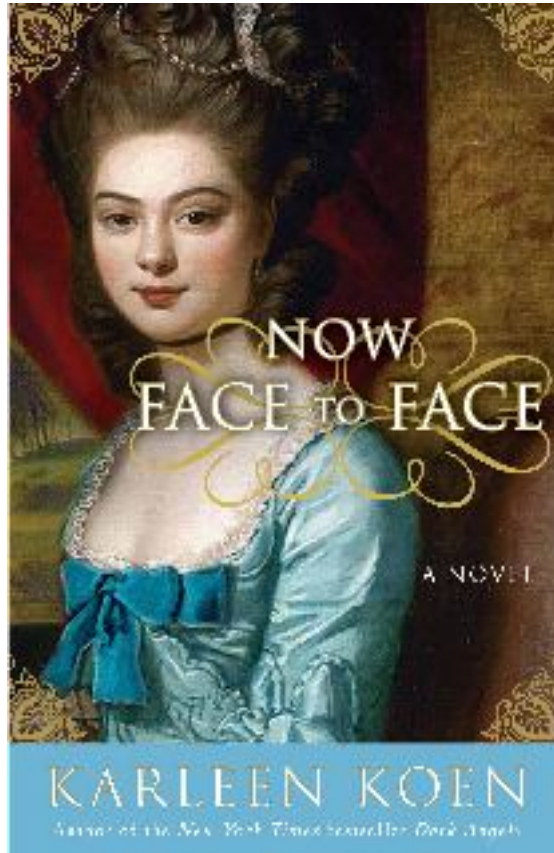


Three Rivers Press Reprints
Karleen Koen's *Now Face to Face*



Three Rivers Press has re-released Karleen Koen's second novel, *Now Face to Face*. Set in Virginia and England in the 1720s, the novel tells the story of a young widow ruined by the crash of the South Sea Bubble who embarks for colonial Virginia and is pulled into a Jacobite plot that threatens the throne, her family, and a new love. *Now Face to Face* sweeps readers from the plantations of Virginia to Hanoverian England and brings both worlds vividly to life.

First published in 1996 by Random House, *Now Face to Face* was a Book of the Month Club main selection.

"I'm excited to have this novel back on the shelves," said Koen. "Three Rivers was kind enough to allow me to write an afterword, which includes a scene I dropped from the original manuscript."
